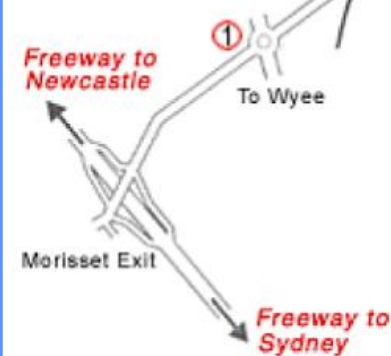

Directions from Newcastle

Follow the Freeway south from Newcastle and follow the Morisset exit. Turn left towards Morisset and follow the directions below from the roundabout (marked with a ① on the map).

Directions from Sydney

Follow the Freeway north from Hornsby towards Newcastle and take the Morisset exit. Turn right towards Morisset and follow the directions below from the roundabout (marked with a ① on the map).



Directions from Point ①

From the roundabout, drive past the Golf Club and continue through Morisset and over the Railway Bridge. Take the third turn on the right at the signpost "Crusaders Campsite" etc. Follow Fishery Point Road for approximately 2km till you come to a Telephone Exchange on the right. Turn left there and after approximately 3km turn left into Yarrowonga Park Road (Signposted to Yarrowonga Park & Balcolyn). The Youth Centre is on the left hand side of the road after approximately 1km.

Traveling by Train?
